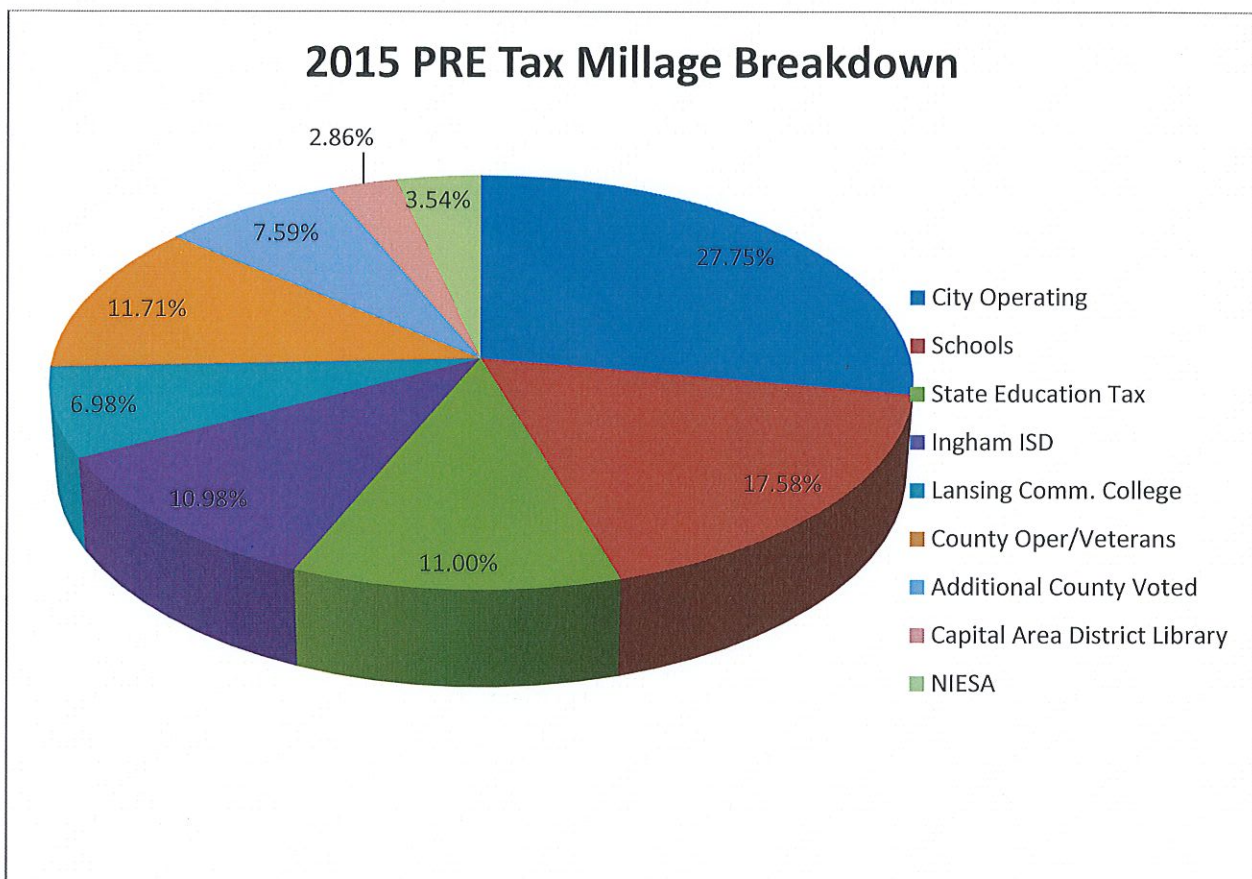


The following charts show how every dollar that is paid to the City in taxes gets disbursed.

The City of Williamston collects taxes for other taxing jurisdictions such as the Williamston Schools, Ingham County, Capital Area District Library, and NIESA.

For every dollar that a Primary Residential Exemption (PRE) homeowner pays, approximately 27.75 cents remains with the City, the remainder is sent to the appropriate taxing jurisdiction that the City collects for.



Likewise, when a non-PRE taxpayer pays their taxes the City keeps approximately 20.86 cents of every dollar paid. This difference between PRE and non-PRE is the exemption of 18 mills for School Operating that PRE properties enjoy.
